## Sample Project - Cambodia

#### Day 1

Start your expedition and travel to your Project location.

#### Day 2

Visit the most famous Cambodia temples, including Angkor Wat, one of the UNESCO Seven Wonders of the World.

#### Day 3 through to Day 5

After your project briefing it's time to get started in your project teams. Work with your Cambodian friends, experience life in the village and make a difference!

#### Day 6

Today we celebrate and officially handover the project with a moving ceremony in the village with the families, children and helpers who made it all possible.

#### Day 7

Visit the Landmine Museum and Angkor National Museum, followed by a walking tour through Siem Reap to visit the markets and different street vendors.

#### Day 8

Visit the base of the Kulen Mountain, take part in a hiking tour through the beautiful countryside finishing at the breathtaking waterfalls for a picnic lunch.

#### Day 9

Travel to Ton Le Sap Lake - take a boat cruise and visit the vibrant and bustling floating fishing villages with floating homes, shops, temples and markets! Transfer to airport.

#### Day 10

Arrive back in Australia this morning.
